<b>Project Description</b>	<p>The World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF), through the Ecological Corridors Fund (ECF), is implementing a large-scale project in Georgia for the conservation and sustainable use of ecosystems and natural resources. Slovenia has already co-financed part of a programme in the Adigeni municipality for the conservation and sustainable use of the landscape with a grant, which included a forest inventory, the preparation of sustainable forest and rangeland management plans, knowledge transfer and the purchase of forestry equipment. This project will include the preparation of guidelines for the construction of forest roads, a forest-recreation plan with pilot sites for picnics and campsites, and a number of training courses and training courses to transfer Slovenian knowledge and experience in forest management. The project has a positive impact on the environment by conserving biodiversity and contributing to the development of sustainable forest use.</p>
